...established digital community hubs, that allow us to have two-way conversations with displaced people in more than 30 countries. Through these hubs we can provide displaced people with critical information, legal advice, and access to cash assistance. Our tech partners support the digital transformation of our operations by offering expertise, funding, a telephony platform, free SMS messaging, phone calls, and other essential resources, which is accelerating the delivery of humanitarian aid.

...expanded the reach of our Better Learning Programme to provide education and psychosocial support for displaced children who are experiencing high levels of stress and trauma. It mobilises children's support networks of caregivers, teachers and school counsellor and takes a broad approach to helping to restore a sense of normality and hope. Our programme is now being implemented in 33 countries, and aims to empower half a million displaced children and youth to reach their full potential.

...support people with information, counselling and legal assistance, that helps people navigate complex administrative and legal procedures to regain access to basic services. Our work focuses on areas like housing and land rights, identity and civil documentation, employment law, and legal stay. Securing civil or identity documentation is critical for accessing education for children, finding employment, getting married and achieving financial stability.

...reach more people with our emergency response, providing first line response for people in acute need. In recent years, the private sector has been instrumental in supporting our emergency response addressing the escalations of conflict in Gaza and Ukraine, earthquake in Syria, the war in Sudan and flooding in Libya. This support has included provision of tents, mattresses, hygiene items, clean water and hot meals. As well as distributing emergency cash so that those fleeing can buy what they need the most.
